The Process

A custom made piece begins with your idea and takes shape through dialogue, craftsmanship and attention to detail. The process is about creating a piece that feels personal and harmonious in both form and expression. A custom design typically takes between 3 and 8 weeks, depending on complexity and materials.

Each piece is crafted with calm precision to ensure a balance between strength and lightness.

Pricing and Transparency

Prices vary depending on the complexity of the design and the materials used.

Transparency is a core value at Ørsted Creations, and price ranges are outlined to make the process clear and reassuring. If you have a set budget, it's helpful to share it at the beginning so that design and materials can be adjusted to reflect both your vision and your style.

What's Included

- Design consultation (online or in person)
- Sketch phase and one design revision
- Depending on the design: wax model, silver prototype, direct work in the chosen material, or casting
- Adjustment to the desired size
- Professional polishing and finish in your preferred look

Sizing and Adjustment

All rings are made to fit and include size adjustment.

For gold rings, the prototype is adjusted to the desired size before casting.

After casting, only minor adjustments are possible depending on the design.

Rings in 925 Sterling Silver

From 2500DKK: Classic, simple ring without texture, symbolism or special adjustments (incl. standard size).

From 3200DKK: Ring with light texture or organic forms – e.g. uneven surface, small variations or soft asymmetry.

From 4200DKK: Complex, organic or asymmetrical designs – e.g. distinct textures, handcrafted details or unique structural elements.

From 5200DKK: Designs with depth, layering or movement – e.g. twisted threads, combined forms or symbolic detailing.

Earrings in 925 Sterling Silver

From 2500DKK: Classic, simple earrings without texture, symbolism or special adjustments (incl. standard size).

From 3200DKK: Earrings with light texture or organic forms – e.g. uneven surface, small variations or soft asymmetry.

From 4200DKK: Complex, organic or asymmetrical designs – e.g. distinct textures, handcrafted details or unique structural elements.

From 5200DKK: Designs with depth, layering or movement – e.g. twisted threads, combined forms or symbolic detailing.

Additions and Adjustments

Engraving or personal symbols: 600–1800DKK

4K gold plating: 600–1000DKK

If you wish for further adjustments, an extended design phase, or a special surface treatment, additional time will be added according to the extra work required.

Solid Gold — 14K and 18K

All gold rings from Ørsted Creations are made in solid 14K or 18K gold and produced as custom made orders.

Each piece is created individually and requires a specific process, as the gold is cast specifically for you.

Price Structure

The total price covers the design phase, time, adjustments, unique craftsmanship and artistic work.

The production price includes casting, prototyping and the gold material.

Price Calculation

The final price is always determined by:

- The current gold price at the time of production
- The weight of the piece and chosen gold karat (14K or 18K)
- The complexity and technical aspects of the design
- The time and craftsmanship involved in the design and production process

Clients receive a written price estimate and approve the design, materials and price range before production begins.

Deposit - A minimum deposit of **8500DKK** is required to begin the process.

If the weight of the ring and therefore the production cost exceed this amount, the deposit will be adjusted accordingly.

The deposit is deducted from the final price.

Commitment - Once the deposit is paid and production has begun, it is non-refundable.

As gold pieces are cast specifically for you, the order cannot be cancelled once the casting process has started.

Final Payment - When the piece is fully completed and the final price has been calculated, the remaining balance is paid by invoice before delivery.
